- 3. What is your research experience in these areas so far? Any upper-level research papers, theses, archaeological or curatorial experience, or other advanced research projects in those areas would be very helpful for us to know about.
- 4. How would you characterize your experience or ability in the study of ancient Greek and Latin so far?
- 5. Have you had any previous experience as a teaching assistant, grader, or tutor for undergraduate Classics courses?
- 6. How would you characterize your ability to function individually and interpersonally in a group professional or classroom setting?
